Going Deeper:

1. Prayer requests & prayer - How can we be praying for one another this week? Share any specific needs, struggles, or areas where you would appreciate prayer.

2. Read Ephesians 4:25-32. Paul addresses several areas of everyday Christian life, including our words, anger, relationships, work, and how we treat others.

- * Which of these areas do you find yourself struggling with most?
- * What does Paul instruct us to do in response to these struggles?
- * What is one practical step you could take this week to put these instructions into practice?

3. Read Colossians 3:12-17. Paul reminds believers of what God has done for us and then calls us to live differently toward one another.

- * How should God's grace and forgiveness toward us motivate us to show grace and forgiveness toward others?
- * In what ways does God's treatment of us provide the model for how we should treat others?
- * What are some concrete, practical ways we can put these commands into practice in our homes, workplaces, churches, and relationships this week?

4. Read Colossians 4:2. Paul encourages us to devote ourselves to prayer, to remain watchful, and to pray with thanksgiving.

- * Take some time to thank God together for the things shared and for His work in each person's life.
