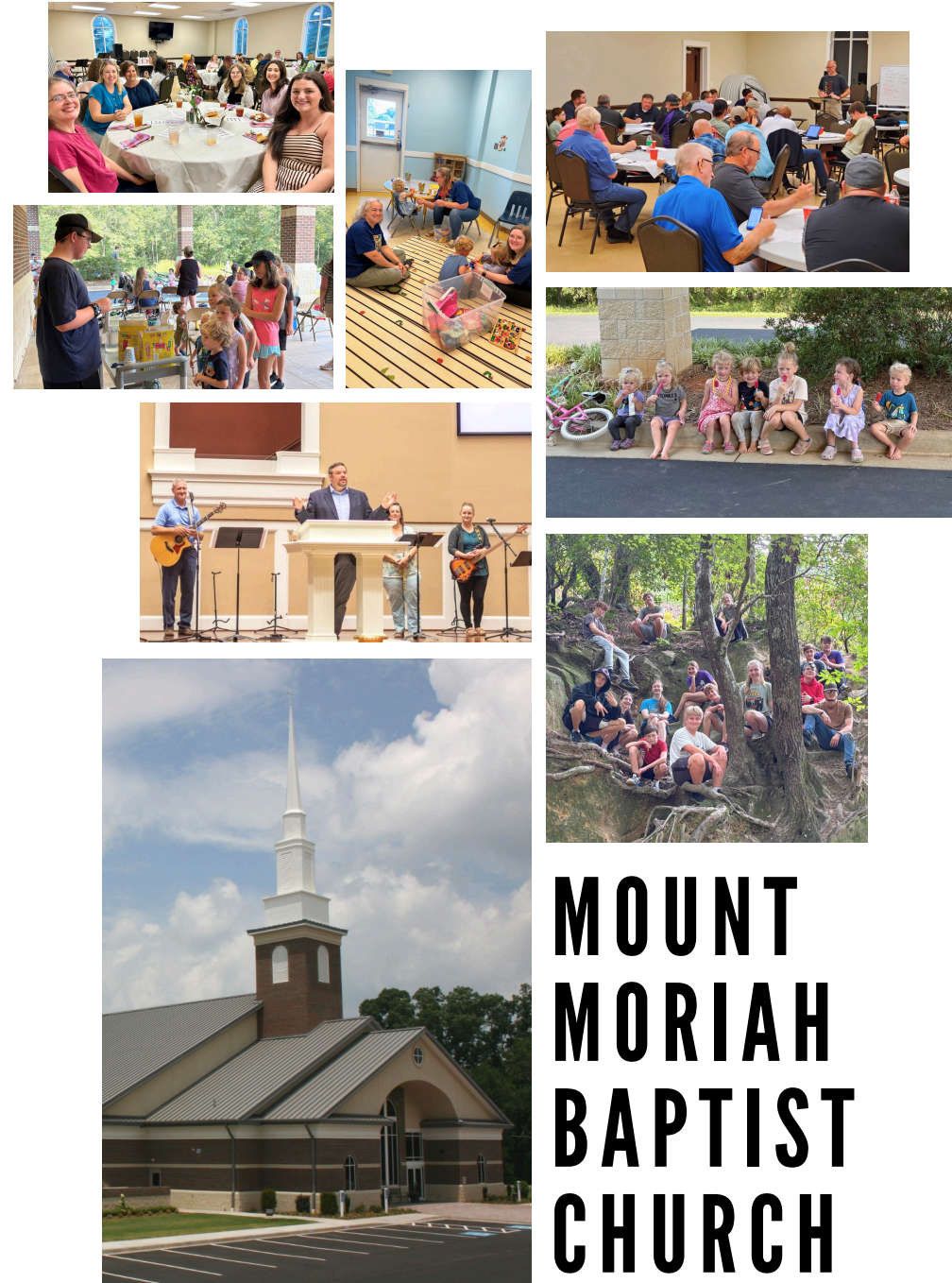
Gifts and their Purpose Ephesians 4:11-16

Series: Grace Gifts

Theme: Christ gave foundational and continuing gifts to the church so that it may grow to spiritual maturity.

Going Deeper:

1. Read Romans 12:1-2. Briefly discuss these verses. Now discuss: how are these verses foundational for Christians so they will have the right view of their lives before God for using their spiritual gifts?
2. Read Romans 12:3-8. Discuss the attitudes believers should have toward spiritual gifts? Discuss the actions we should take as found in v. 6. Why is this challenging? Give some examples of how each of the listed gifts in vv. 7-8 can be used. Since gifts are to be used to help others, share some ways you have been built up spiritually by people using their gifts.
3. Read Romans 12:9-21. What are some of the prominent commands given here? Do you see ways spiritual gifts can be displayed in these commands? What are some aspects from this passage you want to try to do this week?
